

Only the small print indicates that this is a subscription-based purchase, as well as the pricings after the initial sample and the cancellation and refund policies.

There is a small print indicating that a "4-month or longer subscription is required for the Course" as well as "Total charge for the 4 deliveries will be ¥12,500" and "see here to cancel orders and for refunds."
