Caution Against Infection: Latter Period (Level 2)

Date of Implementation: February 10th, 2022 18:00

The omicron variant is spreading to the elderly from children, youth, and families.

Please take even further caution to prevent the spread of infection.

Thoroughly take fundamental measures to prevent the spread of infection!

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Wear your mask properly

Even when eating, wear a mask when speaking.

Wear a non-woven mask that is effective against droplets, and wear it correctly so that there are no gaps!

Frequently ventilate spaces

Ventilate spaces 2 or more times per hour!

Wash your hands, disinfect your hands, and gargle

Do these things to prevent not only COVID-19, but influenza and other viruses!

Take preventative measures even at home!

Stay in separate rooms and have one person designated as the caregiver. Have everyone wear masks and disinfect places that touched by everyone. Wash dirtied sheets/clothes and tightly seal and throw away trash.

When visiting Tokushima, receive a test!

When visiting Tokushima from other prefectures, make use of the free, general testing system!

Make use of stores that are taking measures to prevent the spread of infection!

Make sure that stores are using systems that have been put into place

“3 stars for corona protection” and the “Tokushima Corona Alert System”.

Cooperate with rules that have been put in place

Cooperate with temperature checks, partitions to prevent the spread of droplets, and other measures!

Review your BCP (business continuity plan)!

For businesses, in that case that COVID-19 spreads among your employees, review your BCP so that your business can continue operations.

Make use of systems put in place!

Consider getting the vaccine!

1. In addition to Asty Tokushima, there are 3 new, large sites conducting vaccinations for the booster shot, so consider getting the booster shot.
2. For those who are unvaccinated (especially those at risk of becoming seriously ill such as the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions), speak with your family doctor and consider getting vaccinated.

Make use of stores that have 3 stars for corona protection

When visiting a restaurant or lodging facilities, make sure that they have a sticker showing that they are following guidelines put in place and that they are registered for the Tokushima Corona Alert System. Make use of stores that have 3 stars for corona protection and that have their staff receive antigen testing.



Testing plans (plans to extend these)

General testing project for times when COVID-19 is spreading (currently until February 28th)

We plan to extend the free testing period for those who have no symptoms and would like to get tested as they are anxious (including those who have been vaccinated).

PCR testing support for those returning to the prefecture (currently until February 28th for those returning)

Plans to extend the PCR testing support period for those living outside the prefecture who return and for students of the prefecture who return home and then return to the prefecture to receive advance testing.
